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| <p>METALS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Aluminum – <i>cans, foil...</i> ✓ Steel – <i>cans, lids, nails, screws...</i> ✓ Tin - <i>cans</i> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Place all items in “can” section of Multi-bin. |
| <p>PLASTICS - <i>clear and all colors</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Milk, detergent, juice jugs... ✓ Soda, water bottles... ✓ Lids ✓ Bubble wrap ✓ Grocery bags ✓ Transparencies <p>No Styrofoam</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ We recycle type 1, 2, 3 & 4 type plastic. Place in “plastic bottle” section of Multi-bin. ➤ Containers should be empty with lid REMOVED. |
| <p>GLASS - <i>clear and all colors</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Bottles, jars... ✓ Broken windows, basketball backboards... | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Place all items in “mixed glass” section of Multi-bin. ➤ Large amounts of BROKEN GLASS - place in a bucket or box and submit a Work Order on Ubusiness for special pick-up. This service is FREE! |
| <p>PAPER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Books - <i>paperbacks, hardbacks, textbooks, phonebooks, magazines, notebooks...</i> ✓ Bags - <i>brown paper, pet food bags...</i> ✓ Boxes* ✓ Calendars ✓ Carbonless Paper ✓ Cards - <i>greeting cards, index cards...</i> ✓ Chipboard -<i>cracker boxes, cereal boxes...</i> ✓ Computer and copier paper ✓ Corrugated cardboard ✓ Envelopes - <i>with or without windows</i> ✓ Folders - <i>manila, file folders...</i> ✓ Junk Mail ✓ Newspaper ✓ Notebook paper - <i>stapled, clipped or bound</i> ✓ Poster board ✓ Post-It Notes ✓ Shredded paper* ✓ Tissue paper <p>No Kleenex</p> <p>No Items with food on it -<i>pizza boxes...</i></p> <p>No Carbon Paper</p> <p>No Wax Paper</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ If you have boxes, books, magazines, or unusual amounts of paper submit a Work Order on Ubusiness for a special pick-up. This service is FREE! ➤ BOXES – Flatten and place behind Multi-bin in your building. Large amounts of cardboard/boxes can be taken to: Lionfish Drive - <i>next door to University Police</i> Dobo – <i>dock area</i> Watson – <i>service entrance area</i> Cameron – <i>south entrance area</i> Library – <i>loading dock</i> Trask – <i>loading dock</i> Alderman – <i>first floor entrance near Hoggard</i> Warwick – <i>dumpster area</i> Fisher – <i>loading dock, dumpster area</i> ➤ SHREDDED PAPER – Bag and place beside Multi-bin in your building. ➤ Tear pizza box in half and recycle part with no food on it. |
| <p>BATTERIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Rechargeable batteries ✓ Button batteries ✓ Cell phone batteries ✓ Lead acid batteries ✓ UPS – <i>Uninterruptible Power Supply</i> <p>No Alkaline batteries</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All batteries - call EH&S for pickup x7017. ➤ UPS stops working? It is probably just the battery. You can replace the battery for about half the price of a new UPS. ➤ ALKALINE BATTERIES - have been deemed safe for the landfill. We are no longer able to recycle these for free. |

Call Rapid Refills on Racine Drive. They will come to your office and refill your toner cartridges for approximately half the price of a brand new one. |
